Good Morning Councillor Perry

We met a few months ago, as we were considering our response to the proposals. As you will be aware, CRA has submitted representations against HSG20. I understand that there will be a meeting of the planning committee on 3 October, where a number of matters will be discussed regarding the LDP, particularly now that the Scottish Government has approved the SESPlan.>

There are 2 matters that I would like to draw to your attention. The first is the suggestion that late representations will be considered.

In that regard, I refer to an email sent earlier today to Alison Kirkwood objecting to that proposal, with particular reference to the representation by Braehaed Partnership & Gladman Development Ltd. If you need to see that email, please let me know, but I would expect Alison to draw it to your attention, as to proceed with consideration of the HSG20 proposal and add in the land that Braehaed suggest would be quite contrary to natural justice.

Secondly, I note with some concern that the land at HSG20 is not in the constituency of any member of the planning committee. On the other hand, members of the committee do represent several of the other areas of proposed development. This will no doubt make it difficult for the committee to avoid suggestions of bias, but I am sure that as convenor, you will ensure an even handed approach. You will appreciate our concern that as we have no councillor to speak for us at the committee, it is more important than ever that fairness dictates proceedings.

I realise that you have a very difficult task, to find the necessary land to meet Government house building requirements. But I am confident that this can be done without green belt destruction in our corner of Edinburgh.
