Mr McCulloch,

The Planning Committee agreed to accept all the late representations to the Proposed Local Development Plan that were identified in the report. The Committee decided that a consistent approach to the late representations was necessary and that it was reasonable to allow them as they were submitted shortly after the period for representations closed on 14 June 2013 (they were submitted before the end of June).

There will be the opportunity to comment on any of the matters raised when a modified Proposed Local Development Plan is published.

I note your comments with regard to not having a local Councillor who sits on the Planning Committee, however members of the Planning Committee do not represent their individual wards and make decisions based on what they believe is right for the city as a whole. There will be further opportunity for groups such as yours, as well as the Councillors who represent your ward, to make their views known to the Committee members prior to any decision.
